Here are the guidelines for the presentation:

- Your presentation should be 5-8 minutes.
- Your presentation should accurately cover major content areas – using combinations of summary, paraphrase, and direct quotation to cover each important point.
- Your presentation should use examples and models where possible.
- You should use some form of visual presentation: that may be a PowerPoint or Prezi, a website, a fancy Word or Publisher document, etc.
- Interactive presentations with audience participation is encouraged but be mindful of your time.
- Your group should have some form of assessment to determine whether or not your audience understood the material.

Working with the team:

- Each team member will both generate content and have a role in project production. See Project notes for specifics.
- Each team member is expected to document all of the work he or she contributes to the project
- Each team member will complete a Collaboration Report at the end of the project to describe their contributions to the project
