Reflection Project



The Reflection Project is a continuation of the reflections we have been doing all semester. For this final assignment, you will be asked to reflect back on the whole semester and explain what you have learned. Then, you will be asked to project forward into a time in which you will use what you have learned.

Submission

- Please write your reflection in a document and place it into your folder in Google Drive.
- Name your file with your name, your class, and the assignment (e.g. Malcolm Reynolds ENG 3860 Reflection).

Content Requirements

The Reflection must include:

- A minimum of 1000 words.
- A minimum of three things you have learned this semester.
- A minimum of three contexts in which what you have learned will be used.
- At least two pieces of media (such as screen shots, clips, or images).

Learning Objectives

- To think critically and mindfully about what you have learned this semester.
- To connect learning across contexts.
- To consider how what you have learned might be used elsewhere.
- To encourage learning transfer.

Grading

The following criteria will be used to determine grades for the Reflection Project:

Expectations	Exceptional	Met	Not Met
Explanation	You explain more than three things you learned and use specific examples that help to clarify what you learned.	You explain at least three things that you learned. You use examples from the class.	Fewer than three things learned in class are explained or no examples are used.

Grading (Continued)

Expectations	Exceptional	Met	Not Met
Projection	For all examples, you connect to a very specific future context in which what you learned will be used. You explain how that knowledge will be used in that context.	For all examples, you connect to a future context in which you will use what you learned. You explain how you will use that knowledge.	Future contexts are not connected to or how learning will be used is not explained.
Attention to Assignment	You meet the 1000-word requirement and use outside media.	You meet or nearly meet the 1000-word requirement.	The Project falls well short of the 1000-word requirement.

Your grade for the Reflection Project will be determined by how well you meet the above criteria. One “not met” cancels out one “exceptional.”
